# WORD

**25 Who cuts a channel for the flooding rain or clears the way for lightning, 26 to bring rain on an uninhabited land, on a desert with no human life, 27 to satisfy the parched wasteland and cause the grass to sprout?**

**Job 38:25-27 HCSB**

As this is being written there is a constant light rain shower falling outside. Rain, though it sometimes messes up our plans, is necessary for life to be sustained. Too much rain too quickly and flooding occurs. Not enough rain for an extended period and a drought occurs. To avoid drought, rains like the one I am experiencing today is needed. Without a steady replenishing of water in the ground, things will soon will begin to dry up. The same is true for us spiritually as well. We are like a desert place, a parched wasteland. Just as God is the source of physical water for our land, He is also the source of spiritual water for our souls. God wants to take the dead, dry, and parched wasteland of our life and refresh us. This occurs when we put our faith in Jesus. The Bible tells us that Jesus is the source of the life giving water we all need (**John 4:10**). When we put our faith in Jesus, the source of living water, it restores our souls and forgives our sins. New life begins to grow in us just as grass begins to grow following a rain. Maybe today you are in a spiritual desert. Call out to God and know that through Jesus Christ you can experience the joy of living water in your life. Perhaps today is a good day to read the words of David in **Psalms 63:1**, "God, You are my God; I eagerly seek You. I thirst for You; my body faints for You in a land that is dry, desolate, and without water."
