IN THE WORD

He restores my soul; Psalm 23:3 (NASB)

Restoration. A term that we may often think about in worldly terms. For example, someone is restoring a car or a piece of furniture. We understand the need for restoration because we see that things wear out and break. Typically we desire for things to be beautiful again so we undertake the process restoring them. The same can be said for our souls. As we see David mention in Psalm 23. David says he will not fear the hard times that are upon him because God is restoring him.
