I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

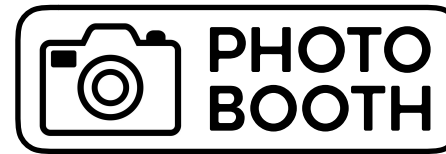
2 Timothy 4:7

SLEEPING BAG MINISTRY UPDATE

Over the past couple of months we received a ton of support for our sleeping bag ministry to help minister to the homeless in New Orleans. I (Shan) want to say thank you for all your prayers and your donations. We were able to collect 83 sleeping bags and tons of socks to hand out to the homeless. We went on our trip to hand them out on October 5 and had a great day! We first stopped underneath an overpass where we encountered about 25 homeless people that we were able to visit with briefly and have prayer with. When we left there we were pointed a few blocks down the street where we encountered many more homeless. People were literally running to us. Many for the sleeping bags of course, but several just wanted prayer. Almost everyone we encountered was very appreciative of the gift and grateful to see us. I think the trip was a blessing to both those who went and the homeless we got to meet. We left with 83 sleeping bags and were able to hand out 80 of them as well as many pairs of socks to the homeless on our trip! Praise the Lord for giving us this opportunity to serve.
