Cinnamon Roll Monkey Bread

Prep: 10 min.
Cook: 28-32 min.
Level: Easy
Serves: 8



Ingredients

- ½ Cup of Sugar
- 2 Teaspoons of Cinnamon (Divided)
- 2 (8 Count) Cans of Pillsbury Grands Cinnamon Rolls
- 1 Cup Brown Sugar
- ½ Cup of Butter (Melted)
- Cinnamon Roll Icing

Preparation

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
2. Lightly grease 12 cup fluted tube or bunt pan.
3. Mix sugar and 1 teaspoon of cinnamon in a ziplock bag.
4. Cut each cinnamon roll into quarters.
5. Shake cinnamon roll pieces in bag to coat.
6. Arrange pieces in pan.
7. Mix brown sugar and 1 teaspoon of cinnamon with ½ cup of butter.
8. Pour over the cinnamon roll pieces in pan.
9. Bake for 28-32 minutes or until golden brown and no longer doughy in the center.
10. Allow to cool in pan for 10 minutes.
11. Turn upside down onto serving plate.
12. Drizzle with cinnamon roll icing.
13. Pull apart to eat.

IN THE WORD

Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden at the time of the evening breeze, and they hid themselves from the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

Genesis 3:8

It was however, a bad time because they had sinned against the Lord. Being in the presence of the Lord is a wonderful thing, unless there is sin in our life. Adam and Eve's sin robbed them of the peace of being in God's presence. Your sin and mine does the same to us. It messes up everything God desired to be good and holy. There is however a way to gain forgiveness for our sins and again be in the peace of God. The only way is through Jesus Christ (**John 14:6**). Jesus restores our peace with God by covering our sins by His death on the cross and resurrection. We no longer have to live in fear of our past mistakes or our current failures, but can fully trust in the peace of our Lord both now and forever more if we have put our faith in Jesus Christ. So next time you feel a gentle breeze let it be a reminder to you that God is there for you and just as the gentle breeze soothes your body, so may the peace of God soothes your soul.
