The Chefs Corner

Chocolate Lasagna

Prep: 20 Minutes

Level: Easy

Serves: 12-15

Ingredients

- 36 Oreo Cookies
- 6 Tablespoons Butter (Melted)
- 8 oz Package Cream Cheese (Softened)
- ¼ Cup Granulated Sugar
- 2 Tablespoons Cold Milk
- 12 oz Cool Whip (More is Better!)
- 2 pkgs Instant Chocolate Pudding (3.9 oz)
- ¾ Cups Cold Milk
- 1½ Cups of Mini Chocolate Chips

Preparation

1. Crush 36 Oreos with food processor or rolling pin.
2. Mix Oreo crumbs with 6 Tbsp of melted butter and cover the bottom of a 9x13 inch baking dish.
3. Mix cream cheese with mixer until light and fluffy. Add in 2 Tbsp of milk and sugar, mix well. Stir in ¼ cup of Cool Whip and spread over Oreo crust.
4. In a bowl, mix chocolate instant pudding with ¾ cups of cold milk. Mix with whisk until thick. Spread over previous layer and let rest for 5 min.
5. Spread remaining Cool Whip on top and sprinkle mini chocolate chips evenly over the top. Place in refrigerator for 4 hours before serving.

Hebrews 13:20-21

Jim Elliot once said “Wherever you are - be all there.” Elliot was a man who lived out this idea to the fullest. In 1955 Elliot and 4 other missionaries attempted to reach a murderous people group in the jungles of Ecuador with the gospel of Jesus. Not long after making contact, the 5 men were speared to death by those they were trying to save. Elliot and the others were undeniably “all there.” We may say “how could these men be willing to give their lives and leave their families behind?” I believe the answer is simple, they were living their lives in the will of God and not their own. Sometimes we may say “God, I am here to be used by you however you need” but are we really all in? Are we really giving God all we have to give? Are we fully committed to God’s will or are we torn, knowing God’s will often calls us to deny our own? The truth is most of us probably struggle with that. We do love the Lord, but the things of the world are quite enticing to us. They are safe and comfortable and while that is what we like, reading through scripture quickly shows us that God typically calls His followers to the dangerous and uncomfortable. Thankfully even though we are not always able to overcome our worldly desires on our own, Jesus is there for us and when we trust Him as Lord in our life He begins to work in us and equip us to be faithful to seek to serve God’s will over our own. When we do, great things happen. While the story of Elliot and the others is sad it does end beautifully. After losing their husbands, the wives and children returned to these murderous people and over the years were able to lead them to Jesus. They are no longer a murderous people, but instead are children of God! The sacrifice of a few resulted in the deliverance of many. What a great testimony of following the example of Jesus.
