

APARTMENT MINISTRY


Every Tuesday @ 9:30 a.m.

You may have heard the old saying "too much of a good thing is a bad thing." This saying proves to be true in most areas of life. Coffee is good, but if we drink too much we are taking in more caffeine than is good for our body. Pies are good, but eating pie continually is unhealthy. Working is a good thing, but working too much may result in us not spending enough time with our family. Hobbies are good, but too much time doing our hobbies may mean that our other responsibilities fall by the wayside. It may be best that we don't seek an abundance of all things good, but learn to be content with a little. Psalm 37:16 says "The little that the righteous man has is better than the abundance of many wicked people." When we have an abundance of anything in life we are tempted to find security and pleasure in that abundance and not in the Lord. When we are content with the Lord we will be content with a little. but when we live in abundance we are seldom satisfied with a little and always want just a little more. The world determines what is considered a little and what is an abundance based on wealth and material gain, but God calls us to seek the abundance of His love. When we live in the abundance of God's love we have a greater wealth than anything the world has to offer. We see the abundance of God's love in His Son Jesus who died on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins. The world often views this truth as insignificant and worthless, but the Bible tells us that the the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus is the most important and precious thing that has ever occurred. The only good thing that we can never have too much of is the Lord. If you are looking for an abundant life today in anything other than Jesus you are looking in the wrong place. Stop looking to what the world says is good and look to what scripture says is good, Jesus Christ and Him crucified.
