2 Corinthians 12:9

We live in a world in which showing any kind of weakness is viewed as a negative. Many times we are taught to show no sign of weakness at all, but as is often the case the Bible says just the opposite of the world has to say. Each and everyone of us have weaknesses, but when dealt with properly our weaknesses can actually make us stronger. In 2 Corinthians 12:9 God told Paul "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Paul responded by saying "Therefore, I will most gladly boast all the more about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may reside in me." When we admit we have weaknesses we must also admit we need extra strength to get through them. Jesus is the strength we all need. There is no shame in admitting your weaknesses, but there is great comfort in seeking Jesus to help you in them. The strongest people are not those who hide their weaknesses, but those who acknowledge them. It is often in our weakest moments that we experience the Lord's strength the most. Don't feel like a failure in your weaknesses today, instead use them as a chance to grow in the Lord's strength.
