Chocolate Molten Lava Cake

Prep: 10 Minutes

Level: Easy

Cook: 10 Minutes

Serves: 4

Ingredients

- 1 Cup of Chocolate Chips
- 3/4 Cup of Granulated Sugar
- 1/2 Cup of All Purpose Flour
- 4 Eggs
- 1/2 Cup of Salted Butter
- 4 Tablespoons Cocoa Powder
- 1 Teaspoon of Vanilla Extract

Preparation

1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees F.
2. Melt butter and chocolate in a bowl.
3. Whisk until blended and set aside.
4. In a separate bowl beats eggs, sugar, and vanilla until well mixed.
5. Add in chocolate syrup and mix well.
6. Sift flour and cocoa powder.
7. Slowly incorporate until well mixed. (If using a hand mixer, use lowest setting.)
8. Pour chocolate batter in ramekins to 3/4 full.
9. Bake for 10 minutes. (Place ramekin on a baking pan for easy removal.)
10. Make sure ramekin is cool and remove cake.

WORD

Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:18

Some of the easiest verses to understand are sometimes some of the hardest to live out. I suspect verses like **1 Thessalonians 5:18** get a fair amount of use during the Thanksgiving season, but sometimes we fail to recognize how good God is because of all the bad we see go on in our lives and in the world. We have a tendency to forget the good in our life and dwell on the bad and when we do that it becomes hard to give thanks in everything. I think this is one of the devil's greatest tactics in keeping us from thanking God and being content with Him. Let me suggest 2 ways that may help us learn how to be thankful and continue to be thankful to God even in hard times. **1.) We can take a moment to reflect on our lives and realize just how great God's grace is to love wretched sinners like us and send Jesus to die for the forgiveness of our sins and 2.) By learning to be content in every situation in our lives.** I believe that recognizing those two things will help us to continue to thank God even on our toughest days. It may also be helpful if we stop and thank God for what we do have instead of being angry at Him about what we don't have. It is hard to be thankful to a God that we are angry at, but it is easy to thank God when we realize He has already given us for more than we deserve in Jesus. Life is not always easy and God doesn't always give us everything we want, but He is a God who loves us with the truest love there is and His provisions for us are far greater than simply providing for our human desires. Most importantly He provides the redemption of our souls in Jesus Christ if we follow Him and that is something that I hope everyone reading this will be eternally thankful for.
