GET READY!

We are excited you will be joining us this year to serve at the Operation Christmas Child Processing Center in Grapevine TX. We pray that God will bless each one serving and more importantly the recipients of the shoeboxes. It will be a weekend of work and a little fun too! This booklet contains some helpful info for the trip.

THE RIDE OVER

Everyone who would like to take their own vehicle is welcome to do so. If you have extra room and are open to having others ride, please offer them an invitation. Each vehicle is welcome to go at their own pace and stop as often as they like or you can run with the pack.

GROUP ACTIVITIES

Throughout this itinerary you will see several planned meals and excursions for our group, they will be highlighted in red on each day's itinerary. If you would like to join the group, great! If not, no worries! You are welcome to fly solo or hang with the crew, your choice.

FOOD

Everyone is responsible for their own meal expense. If you are attending the pre planned group meals the price range is listed for each location. You are welcome to eat anywhere you like. Chick-Fil-A will be available at the shoebox processing center. The hotel will offer free breakfast and there is a Waffle House in the hotel parking lot. If you just want to chill in your room, you can use Grub Hub or other meal delivery services.

Throughout this booklet you will find QR codes to give you more information about the places we will visit and menus to our dining experiences. Check out the itinerary for each day and get ready for an awesome weekend!

TO THE WORK!



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The OCC processing center is only 1 minute from our hotel. We will leave at 8:30am sharp Friday and Saturday mornings. The doors will open at 9am. Upon entry we will sign in and receive our name tags and station assignment. We will likely be split into two stations since our group is so large. Below is a list of jobs to be carried out at each station.

MONEY RETRIEVAL

Cartons of shoeboxes will arrive at each station by a conveyor. There will be a person on each side of the table responsible for removing the shoeboxes from the carton, looking through them for any money included for shipping, and depositing it into the secure money box. Once the money is removed the box will be handed off to the inspectors.

INSPECTION

During the inspection process workers on each side of the table will go through each box carefully. If there are any inappropriate items in the box they are to be removed and placed in a bin (discarded items will be donated to the needy). If a box doesn't contain enough items, filler items will be provided to fill the box. Once the box is inspected it will be handed off to the tapers.

TAPING

Those who are taping will grab inspected boxes and tape them with the provided tape machines at each table to ensure they won't pop open. Once taped, the boxes will be handed off to the carton sorters.

SORTERS

Those sorting will take the taped boxes and place them in the appropriate carton. One side of the table will be for girls, the other for boys. There will be three cartons on each side and the boxes are to be placed in the carton that matches the shoebox age range. As cartons are filled they will be placed on a conveyor and replaced with an empty carton.

SCANNER

Each table will be equipped with 2 electronic scanners. Every shoebox will have a scannable QR code for tracking purposes. The person working the scanner must scan each box followed by scanning the corresponding carton it is placed in.

OTHER JOBS TO CONSIDER

You may also have the opportunity to assist in other jobs as well. These include working in the shoebox hospital, keeping stations provided with new cartons, and a variety of other jobs.
