Hershey's "Perfectly Chocolate" Chocolate Cake

Prep: 25 min. Difficulty: Easy
Cook: 30-35 min. Serves: 12 people

Ingredients

- 2 Cups of Sugar
- 1¼ Cups of All Purpose Flour
- ¾ Cup of HERSHEY'S Cocoa
- 1½ tsp of Baking Powder
- 1½ tsp of Baking Soda
- 1 tsp of Salt
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Cup of Milk
- ½ Cup of Vegetable Oil
- 2 tsp Vanilla Extract
- 1 Cup of Boiling Water

Preparation

1. Heat oven to 350°F. Grease and flour two 9-inch round baking pans.
2. Stir together sugar, flour, cocoa, baking powder, baking soda and salt in large bowl. Add eggs, milk, oil and vanilla; beat with mixer on medium speed for 2 minutes. Stir in boiling water (batter will be thin). Pour batter into prepared pans.
3. Bake 30 to 35 minutes or until wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes; remove from pans to wire racks. Cool completely. Frost with "PERFECTLY CHOCOLATE" CHOCOLATE FROSTING.

"PERFECTLY CHOCOLATE" FROSTING:

- ½ Cup (1 stick) Butter or Margarine
- ¾ Cup HERSHEY'S Cocoa
- 3 Cups Powdered Sugar
- ½ Cup Milk
- 1 tsp Vanilla Extract

1. Melt butter. Stir in cocoa. Alternately add powdered sugar and milk, beating to spreading consistency.
2. Add small amount additional milk, if needed. Stir in vanilla. Makes about 2 cups frosting.

It is honorable for a man to resolve a dispute, but any fool can get himself into a quarrel.

Proverbs 20:3

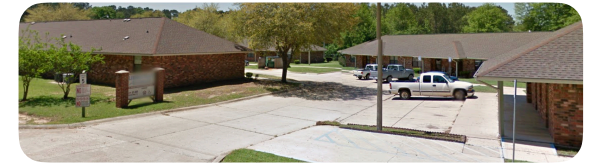
It is inevitable disputes will occur in life. We may not always be responsible for starting the dispute but we can be responsible for stopping it. Proverbs 20:3 says this is an honorable quality to have. It is a rare quality as well because it is a hard thing for us to do. Often times when we are in the middle of a dispute we are passionate about we are too proud to stop the bickering and we continue on full speed with our opponent. Other times we may be around others who are disputing but instead of trying to be a voice of reason we are really enjoying the drama of the whole situation and it gives us a good story to tell others so we just sit back and enjoy the show. This is what the Bible would label as foolishness. To jump right into a dispute is very foolish yet often we are ready to dive head first into trouble. This is what we must fight against. Surely you would rather be a man/woman of honor and not a fool? This may mean keeping your mouth shut when someone is coming against you or speaking up for others in the midst of their dispute. I will even be so naive to say I believe most situations can be resolved should the parties involved remain sensible. When you handle situations honorably three things happen 1) God is pleased with you 2) You will be at peace about it and 3) Others involved will recognize you as a sensible man/woman of God. This is our opportunity to show others the love of God and represent Him in a way that brings honor to Him. If we want to learn what perfect honor looks like we need not look any further than Jesus on the cross, that is our example.
