# WORD

**Little children, we must not love with word or speech, but with truth and action.**

**1 John 3:18 HCSB**

What do you say when there are no words to say? This is something I have thought about more in recent years. There are some occasions, in particularly funerals, at which it often seems that there isn't much we can say to help stop the pain. We may say things like "let me know if there is anything I can do for you" or "this is all part of God's plan" and though there may be some level of truth to that statement and while we may offer such words with a pure and loving heart, those words may fall flat in times of deep pain. Perhaps there are better ways to help those who are hurting. There are two things that I have considered in recent months. The first is that we make sure to share God's Word with people to help them in their time of trouble. Don't misunderstand, there is nothing wrong with the heartfelt words we may offer, but I believe it is good when we memorize a scripture or two to share with those who need encouragement in their time of pain. Our words may provide some comfort, but we can be assured that God's Word is powerful and effective. The second, and perhaps the most important thing we can do for those in pain is to love them. I came to this conclusion a couple of weeks back and realized that our words of comfort may fail if they are not followed by our actions. Afterward I experienced this first hand at a funeral I recently attended. I asked a member of the family if there was anything we could do for them and they responded, "just love me". When others are in times of great heartache and pain we don't just need to tell them we love them, we need to show them. Perhaps we can put a card in the mail, give them a call, send them a text message, make them a meal or take them out, and maybe the most important thing we can do is go visit them. Maybe someone you know needs to be loved today. Maybe you often think about things you should do, but never get around to it. Perhaps its time to get around to it! There is no better time that the present to stop putting off your opportunities to love and start living them out. Ask God to help you to see ways you can love others and then ask Him to give you the strength and guidance on how to carry out that love.
