### For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. Psalm 62:5 ESV

Even worse, your deadline is approaching and it as if you are playing a game of hide and seek with your due date, "ready or not here I come!" Thankfully I have discovered throughout the years that these times pass. Perhaps you would not label my condition as writers block, but insanity! If so, pray for me! On the other hand, maybe you know exactly what I am talking about! If so, then you will be encouraged to know that you are not alone. I said all of that to say this, there are days when in the midst of a mental block that I sit in the silence of my mind with no clear direction. In those times I have learned to simply wait. Because I know that in the silence, I am not alone, but that God is with me and will see me though it. Sometimes we simply must wait on the Lord.
