IN THE WORD

*Plans fail when there is no counsel, but with many advisers they succeed. **Proverbs 15:22 (HCSB)***

Wisdom, a valuable thing that everyone needs desperately even if we fail to realize it. If you are an adult you know exactly what I mean. We may fail to appreciate wisdom in our younger years, but we begin to appreciate it a lot more once we have some life experiences under our belt. The best place to seek wisdom is the Bible.
