

#### **BAGS OF LOVE**



How happy is the man who does not follow the advice of the wicked or take the path of sinners or join a group of mockers!

Psalms 1:1 HCSB

When it comes to the paths that are a result of obedience to God we need to KEEP MOVING, KEEP OUR EYES ON GOD, and STAY ON THE STRAIGHT AND NARROW PATH! If you are on a path of sin, you are on a slippery slope! Repent! Even on the path of righteousness, however, it may at times feel like you can't go on any further, but know that wherever we are in life, God is there to lift us up, be our help, and hold us up when we begin to slip but we have to call out to Him and ask Him to save us!
